SB2007 Status and Testimony	RELATING TO STATE COUNCIL ON MENTAL HEALTH. Amends the principal state agencies of the State Council on Mental Health and defines quorum for the Council.	CPH, WAM
SB2008 Status and Testimony	RELATING TO SERVICE AREA BOARDS. Amends statutory provisions relating to quorum requirements for service area boards on mental health and substance abuse.	CPH, WAM
SB2076 Status and Testimony	RELATING TO HEALTH CARE. Establishes a durable medical equipment supplier licensure program for suppliers of durable medical equipment, prosthetics, orthotics, and related supplies through the office of health care assurance. Allows license fees to be deposited into the office of health care assurance special fund. Amends the cap on amounts of the health care assurance special fund that may be used per fiscal year. Amends the balance of the health care assurance special fund above which moneys are deposited into the general fund.	CPH, WAM
SB2319 Status and Testimony	RELATING TO INSURANCE. Requires insurers to cover a three-month period for the first dispensing of prescription contraceptive supplies to an insured. Requires insurers to cover a twelve-month period for the subsequent dispensing of the same contraceptive supply to the insured.	CPH, WAM



SB2320 Status and Testimony	<p>RELATING TO CONTRACEPTIVE SUPPLIES.</p> <p>Authorizes pharmacists to prescribe and dispense contraceptive supplies to persons eighteen years of age or older. Specifies requirements pharmacists must meet prior to prescribing and dispensing contraceptive supplies. Requires all insurers in the State, including health benefits plans under chapter 87A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, and medicaid managed care programs, to reimburse pharmacists who prescribe and dispense contraceptive supplies.</p>	CPH, JDL
SB2317 Status and Testimony	<p>RELATING TO HEALTH.</p> <p>Establishes the Hawaii maternal mortality review panel within the department of health to conduct a comprehensive review of maternal deaths that have occurred in the State. Makes an appropriation.</p>	CPH, JDL/WAM
SB2675 Status and Testimony	<p>RELATING TO LICENSING.</p> <p><u>Requires dentist, physician, osteopathic physician, physician assistant, nurse, and pharmacist licensee applicants who have had a license, permit, or ability to practice suspended in another jurisdiction to undergo a hearing to show cause why suspension should be terminated prior to being issued a license to practice in Hawaii. Requires the board of dental examiners, Hawaii medical board, board of nursing, and board of pharmacy to summarily suspend a Hawaii license upon a determination that a licensee has had a license, registration, or ability to practice suspended or revoked in any other jurisdiction, pending a hearing to show cause. Requires orders of summary suspension or disciplinary action taken due to actions arising in other jurisdictions to be public record.</u></p>	<u>CPH, JDL</u> [Measure added on 2/3/2016]
SB2815 Status and Testimony	<p>RELATING TO PROFESSIONALLY LICENSED OR CERTIFIED GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES.</p> <p><u>Adds a new section to chapter 662, Hawaii Revised Statutes, providing professionally licensed or certified government employees with the same privileges and immunities as other state employees.</u></p>	<u>CPH, JDL</u> [Measure added on 2/3/2016]
SB2665 Status and Testimony	<p>RELATING TO HEALTH SAVINGS ACCOUNT PROGRAMS.</p> <p><u>Authorizes employers to establish group health savings accounts in addition to group accident and health or sickness insurance policies, group hospital and medical service plan contracts, and HMO plans issued or renewed after July 1, 2016.</u></p>	<u>CPH, WAM</u> [Measure added on 2/3/2016]
