SB2158 Status and Testimony	RELATING TO PROCUREMENT. Prohibits the expenditure of state funds by state agencies for the purchase of single-serving bottled water, except under certain circumstances.	GVO, WAM
SB2293 Status and Testimony	RELATING TO OPEN GOVERNMENT. Allows the electronic mailing and posting of meeting notices; requires the posting of the notice on the state or appropriate county websites; and increases public access to information before a public hearing by a board.	GVO, JDL
SB2157 Status and Testimony	MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE STATE CAPITOL MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE TO REDESIGN THE REFLECTING POOLS. Makes an appropriation to the Department of Accounting and General Services to conduct a study relating to the rehabilitation and renovation of the state capitol reflecting pool.	GVO, WAM
