DECISION MAKING ON THE FOLLOWING MEASURE(S):

SB2495 Status and Testimony	RELATING TO PROCUREMENT. Requires every government procurement officer to attend initial training by the state procurement office and regular follow-up training as determined by the state procurement office.	GVO/PSM, JDL/WAM
SB2493 Status and Testimony	RELATING TO PROCUREMENT. Requires the state procurement policy board to perform annual random audits of government purchasing agencies and audits of agencies selected based on a pattern of agency noncompliance.	GVO, WAM
SB2494 Status and Testimony	RELATING TO PROCUREMENT. Requires the state procurement office to establish a database of all government procurement contracts, accessible to each governmental body. Appropriates funds to establish the database.	GVO, WAM
SB2501 Status and Testimony	RELATING TO PROCUREMENT. Requires past performance to be factored into future bid selection of a contractor. Defines past performance. Requires past performance to be considered in sole source procurement. Appropriates funds. Takes effect on 1/1/2017.	GVO, WAM
SB3092 Status and Testimony	RELATING TO PROCUREMENT. Authorizes procurement officers to permit clarification of a listed subcontractor's scope of work and consider a previously licensed and listed subcontractor's license as valid; provided that certain conditions are satisfied.	GVO, WAM

Technology and the Information and Communication Services
Division of the Department of Accounting and General Services,
including all related information technology functions, in the Office
of Enterprise Technology Services under the direction of the Chief
Information Officer. The amendments are intended to create
greater efficiency in state government and clarify roles and
responsibilities in new governance processes by consolidating the
two programs that already fall under the oversight of the Chief
Information Officer.
