Since 2006, the Department of Health has been authorized to form domestic violence fatality review teams to conduct multidisciplinary and multiagency reviews of domestic fatalities. In 2015, Act 203 was enacted, mandating the conduct of these reviews to include domestic violence fatalities, near-deaths, and suicides to reduce the incidence of preventable intimate partner deaths.

The purpose of this Informational Briefing is to receive an update on the progress, findings, and proposed recommendations for systems reform from the Domestic Violence Fatality Review Team that has been convened by the Department of Health.

No public testimony will be accepted.




