HB 2458, HD2 (HSCR902-16) Status & Testimony	RELATING TO THE GENERAL EXCISE TAX. Establishes a general excise tax at the wholesale rate of an unspecified per cent for the gross proceeds or income from all products produced by Hawaiian loko i'a. (HB2458 HD2)	HWN, WAM
