<p><u>SB 2569</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u></p>	<p>RELATING TO THE COMMUNITY COURT OUTREACH PROJECT. Establishes a community court outreach project in the city and county of Honolulu from July 1, 2016, to June 30, 2020. Requires, under the project, the judiciary to operate a mobile court that travels to community sites where defendants cited or arrested for nonviolent offenses live or congregate and disposes of the cases after plea agreements have been reached by the Honolulu prosecuting attorney and public defender. <p><u>SB 2554</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u></p>	<p>PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO ARTICLE VII, SECTION 6, OF THE HAWAII CONSTITUTION, RELATING TO THE DISPOSITION OF EXCESS REVENUES. Proposes a constitutional amendment to add alternatives for the disposition of excess general fund revenues. Allows the appropriation of general funds for the pre-payment of general obligation bond debt service or pension or other post-employment benefit liabilities.</p>	<p>JDLWAM</p>
<p><u>SB 2755</u> <u>Proposed SD1 (SSCR2306)</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u></p>	<p>RELATING TO A LAW ENFORCEMENT EMPLOYMENT STANDARDS AND TRAINING BOARD. Establishes an advisory law enforcement employment standards and training board responsible for developing statewide employment standards and training for county and state law enforcement officers who carry firearms and wear a badge. Allows the relevant government agencies to voluntarily implement the employment standards and training recommendations. Terminates the advisory board on 6/30/2021. Makes an appropriation for the operation of the advisory board.
