<a href="#"><u>SB 2437</u></a> <a href="#"><u>Status &amp; Testimony</u></a>	RELATING TO CAMPAIGN SPENDING. Changes the name of the Hawaii election campaign fund to the Hawaii citizens' election fund.	JDL, WAM
<a href="#"><u>SB 2438</u></a> <a href="#"><u>Status &amp; Testimony</u></a>	RELATING TO CAMPAIGN FINANCE. Replaces the Hawaii election campaign fund with the general revenues of the State as the funding source for the operating expenses of the campaign spending commission. Appropriates moneys to the commission for operating expenses.	JDL, WAM
<a href="#"><u>SB 2445</u></a> <a href="#"><u>Status &amp; Testimony</u></a>	RELATING TO CAMPAIGN FINANCE. Establishes an exemption from the prohibition against using election campaign funds to make charitable donations or to award scholarships during the period from the filing of nomination papers to the date of the general election, for candidates who are already declared elected to office after running unopposed in an election.	JDL
<a href="#"><u>SB 2444</u></a> <a href="#"><u>Status &amp; Testimony</u></a>	RELATING TO ELECTIONS. Requires the office of elections to join the Electronic Registration Information Center and share information with counties to encourage voter participation and ensure integrity of voter registration rolls. Appropriates moneys.	JDL, WAM
<a href="#"><u>SB 2443</u></a> <a href="#"><u>Status &amp; Testimony</u></a>	RELATING TO ELECTIONS. Requires recounts of election votes when the margin of victory is less than two hundred fifty votes or less than one percent of the votes cast, whichever is less.	JDL, WAM
