<a href="#">SB2196</a> <a href="#">Status and Testimony</a>	RELATING TO THE LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER INDEPENDENT REVIEW BOARD. Establishes the law enforcement officer independent review board within the department of the attorney general to investigate deaths while in law enforcement custody and shootings involving a law enforcement officer where an individual is injured. Appropriates funds.	PSM/JDL, WAM
<a href="#">SB2309</a> <a href="#">Status and Testimony</a>	RELATING TO SEXUAL ASSAULT. Establishes the sexual assault kit tracking program. Requires a law enforcement agency to submit sexual assault kits obtained in connection to a criminal investigation to an authorized laboratory within 10 days, the laboratory to complete analysis within 6 months, and results to be uploaded to the state DNA database and data bank identification program and the Federal Bureau of Investigation Combined DNA Index System. Requires each law enforcement agency that obtains a sexual assault kit in connection to a criminal investigation to report to the department of the attorney general annually on the number of sexual assault kits in its possession. Requires the police department of each county, the department of public safety, and the division of conservation and resources enforcement to submit a report to the legislature prior to the convening of the regular session 2017 on the number of kits in its possession and progress on any backlog. Requires the legislative reports to be made available to the public.	PSM/JDL, WAM
<a href="#">SB2147</a> <a href="#">Status and Testimony</a>	RELATING TO INCARCERATION ALTERNATIVES. Establishes an alternative incarceration pilot program with mandatory electronic monitoring under the department of public safety for parolees and the judiciary for probationers. Establishes criteria for eligibility, conditions, and retake. Makes appropriations. Repeals on 12/31/2019.	PSM/JDL, WAM



<a href="#">SB2179</a> <a href="#">Status and Testimony</a>	RELATING TO DRUG PARAPHERNALIA. Changes drug paraphernalia possession and delivery offenses from felonies to civil violations.	PSM/JDL, WAM
<a href="#">SB2198</a> <a href="#">Status and Testimony</a>	RELATING TO PUBLIC SAFETY. Extends the reentry pilot project for nonviolent, low-risk drug offenders. Makes an appropriation. Repeals on June 30, 2018.	PSM/JDL, WAM

<a href="#">SB3102</a> <a href="#">Status and Testimony</a>	<u>RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF BUSINESS, ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT, AND TOURISM.</u> <u>Allows state agencies to develop and enter into inter-agency agreements without entering into a memorandum of agreement or memorandum of understanding.</u>	<u>GVO/JDL, WAM</u> [Measure added on 2/16/2016]
