Limits the amount of campaign funds that may be spent by an elected official on memberships in civic or community groups or on protocol gifts to twice the allowable individual contribution amount. Appropriates moneys to the Campaign Spending Commission for operating expenses. Transfers excess trust funds to the general fund. (HB2156 HD2)</p>	<p>JDL, WAM</p>
HB2016 HD1 (HSCR681-16) Status and Testimony	<p>RELATING TO PUBLIC EMPLOYEES.</p> <p>Requires public retiree contributions to the EUTF to be paid through withholdings of retirement benefit amounts from the ERS. (HB2016 HD1)</p>	<p>JDL, WAM</p>
HB2006 HD1 (HSCR850-16) Status and Testimony	<p>RELATING TO THE EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM.</p> <p>Reduces the benefit multiplier for judges who become judges, are reappointed, or promoted after June 30, 2016. (HB2006 HD1)</p>	<p>JDL, WAM</p>
HB2028 HD1 (HSCR773-16) Status and Testimony	<p>RELATING TO TAXATION.</p> <p>Exempts personal income tax income and general excise tax income in an amount up to an unspecified percentage of the costs of construction and operation of projects entered into under a public-private partnership with the ERS to improve water infrastructure or water supply, or to promote clean energy. HB1652 HD1 (HSCR868-16) Status and Testimony	<p><u>RELATING TO VOTER REGISTRATION.</u></p> <p><u>Requires an affidavit on application for voter registration to be included as part of the application for driver's licenses and civil identification cards. Prevents processing of application for driver's licenses or civil identification cards unless voter affidavit is complete or declined. RELATING TO PARKING.

Establishes fines beginning January 1, 2017, for owners of parking facilities with at least one hundred parking spaces that do not provide at least one parking space equipped with a charging system exclusively for electric vehicles. Allows for a warning prior to being fined for a first violation. (HB2221 HD1)
