RELATING TO PROFESSIONAL EMPLOYER ORGANIZATIONS. LAB/CPC, FIN
Establishes a tiered scale for the biennial renewal fees for professional employer organizations, based on the number of covered employees a professional employer organization reports to the department of labor and industrial relations. Effective 7/1/2050. (SD2)

DECISION MAKING TO FOLLOW
