<a href="#">SB 2495</a> <a href="#">Status &amp; Testimony</a>	RELATING TO PROCUREMENT. Requires every government procurement officer to attend initial training by the state procurement office and regular follow-up training as determined by the state procurement office.	GVO/PSM, JDL/WAM
