<u>SB 3112</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u>	RELATING TO VIETNAM WAR COMMEMORATION. Appropriates funds for programs, ceremonies, and activities commemorating the 50th Anniversary of the Vietnam War.	PSM, WAM
<u>SB 3113</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u>	RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE. Appropriates funds for the establishment of a veterans services counselor IV position within the Office of Veterans' Services to assist all veterans, with a primary focus on female veterans.	PSM, WAM
<u>SB 2256</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u>	RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLE DRIVER LICENSING. Authorizes issuance of driver's licenses with the notation of "veteran" for persons who are veterans of the Korean conflict.	PSM, TRE
<u>SB 2824</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u>	RELATING TO THE AEROSPACE ADVISORY COMMITTEE. Reduces the number of members on the Aerospace Advisory Committee from fifteen to thirteen. Allows the members of the Aerospace Advisory Committee to elect their own committee chair from members appointed by the Governor to this body. Effective July 1, 2016.	PSM, WAM
<u>SB 2825</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u>	RELATING TO THE PACIFIC INTERNATIONAL SPACE CENTER FOR EXPLORATION SYSTEMS. Eliminates the ex-officio National Aeronautics and Space Administration representative from the Pacific International Space Center for Exploration Systems Board. Effective July 1, 2016.	PSM
<u>SB 2917</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u>	RELATING TO CORRECTIONAL FACILITIES. Creates an exemption from Hawai'i Revised Statutes §343-5 for a jail facility to be built adjacent to Halawa Correctional Facility and funding therefore and makes clarifying amendments.	PSM, WAM
<u>SB 3061</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u>	RELATING TO PUBLIC SAFETY. Allows for and appropriates funds for the state department of defense Hawaii emergency management agency to assemble twenty-five civilian community teams to assist communities during emergencies and disasters and to hire a coordinator to help establish, train, and assist the teams.	PSM, WAM
