<p><u>SB 2534</u> Status & Testimony</p>	<p>RELATING TO PUBLIC PURPOSE PROJECTS REQUIRING PUBLIC UTILITY INVOLVEMENT. Establishes a simplified regulatory process and procurement mechanism for the public utility commission to review public purpose projects and direct public utilities to procure electricity and fuel from the public purpose projects at a rate authorized by the commission.</p>	<p>CPH/TRE, WAM</p>
<p><u>SB 2118</u> Status & Testimony</p>	<p>RELATING TO PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES. Authorizes the examiner of drivers to include information about a person's disability on the person's driver's license or civil identification card.</p>	<p>TRE/CPH, WAM</p>
<p><u>SB 2820</u> Status & Testimony</p>	<p>RELATING TO RENEWABLE ENERGY. Amends the "renewable portfolio standard" definition to more accurately reflect the amount of renewable energy generation in Hawaii by amending the renewable portfolio standard calculation to be based on electrical energy generation as opposed to electrical energy sales.</p>	<p>TRE/CPH, WAM</p>
<p><u>SB 2857</u> Status & Testimony</p>	<p>RELATING TO TOWING. Defines "vehicle owner", "scene", and "hooked up" for the purposes of towing unattended vehicles. Makes clarifying amendments. Specifies that violations of the section shall be per se violations of section 480-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, and repeals prior fine provisions.</p>	<p>TRE/CPH, JDL</p>

RELATING TO ELECTRIC VEHICLES.

TRE/CPH, WAM

Authorizes the public benefits fee to be used to install and upgrade electric power infrastructure to facilitate the use of electric vehicles. Authorizes the public benefits fee administrator to establish procedures for the administration of public benefits fee programs that install or upgrade electric power infrastructure to facilitate the use of electric vehicles. Sunsets on 6/30/2020.
