<u>SB 2715</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u>	RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLE INSPECTIONS. Requires motor vehicles safety inspections to be conducted every two years rather than annually.	TRE, WAM
<u>SB 3075</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u>	RELATING TO TRAILERS. Requires an owner of a trailer bought out-of-state and subsequently brought into the State to provide proof of payment of the use tax with the application for registration unless otherwise exempt.	TRE, WAM
<u>SB 2585</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u>	RELATING TO THE STATEWIDE TRAFFIC CODE. Clarifies when pedestrians may enter a crosswalk equipped with a countdown timer.	TRE
