<u>SB 2083, SD1</u> <u>(SSCR2758)</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO THE STATEWIDE TRAFFIC CODE. Prohibits smoking in a motor vehicle in which a minor is present. Requires the department of health to report on the enforceability and data collection activities of the respective law enforcement agencies. Takes effect on 1/7/2059. (SD1)	TRN, JUD, FIN
<u>SB 2618, SD1</u> <u>(SSCR2800)</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO TRANSPORTATION. Requires the department of transportation to conduct a feasibility study of establishing an interisland ferry system. Makes an appropriation for the study. Effective 1/1/2050. (SD1)	TRN, FIN
<u>SB 2684, SD1</u> <u>(SSCR2527)</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLE INSURANCE. Establishes motor vehicle insurance requirements for transportation network companies and transportation network company drivers. Effective 7/1/2050. (SD1)	TRN, CPC/JUD, FIN
<u>SB 1178, SD2</u> <u>(SSCR847)</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO HEALTH. Increases the authorized benefit for acupuncture treatments allowed under personal injury protection benefits provided through motor vehicle insurance. Ties increases in payments for acupuncture treatments in with annual increases, if any, to the medicare economic index. Effective 7/1/2053. (SD2)	TRN, CPC, FIN
<u>SB 612, SD1</u> <u>(SSCR732)</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO PROBATION. Provides for a period of probation for any person convicted of the offense of operating a vehicle under the influence of an intoxicant. Mandates a period of probation for any person convicted of operating a vehicle after license and privilege have been suspended or revoked for operating a vehicle under the influence of an intoxicant. (SD1)	TRN, JUD, FIN



DECISION MAKING TO FOLLOW
