SB2555 Status and Testimony	RELATING TO STATE FUNDS. Appropriates moneys from the general revenues into the Emergency and Budget Reserve Fund in FY 2015-2016 to comply with article VII, section 6, of the Hawaii State Constitution, which requires, under certain economic conditions, that the legislature provide a tax credit to state taxpayers or make a deposit into one or more funds.	WAM
SB2846 Status and Testimony	MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE EMERGENCY AND BUDGET RESERVE FUND. Makes a general fund appropriation of \$100,000,000 for fiscal year 20162017 to further capitalize the Emergency and Budget Reserve Fund.	WAM
SB2845 Status and Testimony	MAKING APPROPRIATIONS TO REPAY GENERAL FUND CASH ADVANCES. Makes general fund appropriations for fiscal year 20162017 to repay prior general fund cash advances of \$89,900,000 for the purchase of lands of the former Kapalama Military Reservation and of \$13,300,000 for the Hawaii Health Systems Corporation. SB2921 Status and Testimony	RELATING TO CONFORMITY TO THE INTERNAL REVENUE CODE. Conforms Hawaii income and estate and generation-skipping transfer tax laws to the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended as of December 31, 2015, and makes technical, nonsubstantive amendments.	WAM
