<u>HB 2453, HD1</u> <u>(SSCR2973)</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u>	RELATING TO CHARTER SCHOOLS. Appropriates moneys for start-up grants for newly approved, pre-opening, public charter schools. (HB2453 HD1)	EDU, WAM
