Requires the Department of Agriculture to develop and implement an Agricultural Food Safety Certification Program that concurrently complies with the FDA Food Safety Modernization Act as it applies to farmers and ranchers. Authorizes and appropriates funds for program staff. Effective 7/1/2112. (HD1)	WLA/CPH, WAM
<u>HB 2657, HD2, SD1</u> <u>(SSCR2999)</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u>	RELATING TO AGRICULTURE. Amends the Molokai diversified agricultural revolving loan program established by Act 387, SLH 1988, to provide cost reimbursements to Molokai farmers and ranchers to reimburse costs of mandated food safety compliance audits and other related costs. Appropriates funds to the Maui Office of Economic Development to review and approve applications for the loan program. (SD1)	WLA, WAM
<u>HB 1749, HD1, SD1</u> <u>(SSCR3100)</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u>	RELATING TO WATER MANAGEMENT. Amends the goals of the Hawaii water plan to include increased utilization of reclaimed water in all state facilities, where feasible. (SD1)	WLA/GVO, WAM

<p>HB 2037, HD1, SD1 (SSCR3140) Status & Testimony</p>	<p>RELATING TO THE WORLD CONSERVATION CONGRESS. Appropriates moneys to the DLNR to host the International Union for Conservation of Nature World Conservation Congress meeting at the Hawaii Convention Center on September 1-10, 2016. Requires matching private funds. (SD1)</p>	<p>WLA/TSI, WAM</p>
<p>HB 2235, HD1, SD1 (SSCR2887) Status & Testimony</p>	<p>RELATING TO HONOKOHAU SMALL BOAT HARBOR. Authorizes the Board of Land and Natural Resources to transfer the operation, administration, management, and maintenance of Honokohau small boat harbor to a public-private partnership or a private organization. Appropriates funds for repairs and maintenance of the harbor. (SD1)</p>	<p>WLA, WAM</p>
