#### Answers to Senator Baker's Questions:

- (7) Name a previous experience you've had that will be beneficial as a Board member.
  - Served on the Statewide Health Coordinating Council since 2014.
  - Served on the West Oahu Subarea Health Planning Council from 2005 to 2012, and 2015 to the present.
  - Worked for health care organizations Kaiser Permanente Hawaii, AlohaCare, Waianae Coast Comprehensive Health Center, and HMSA.
  - Volunteer work with the Waianae Coast Community Mental Health Center, the Waianae Coast Coalition for Human Services, and the Native Hawaiian Health Care Act Oahu Planning Committee.
  - Community Health Center consultant to medically underserved regions in Saipan, Guam, Palau, Pohnpei, and the Marshall Islands.
- (8) Can you foresee any possible conflicts of interest that could arise during your service on the Board? How would you overcome conflicts of interest?
  - Yes, a conflict of interest is possible. For example, I am employed by Kaiser Permanente Hawaii, and they may have an interest related to a Certificate of Need application.
  - If a possible conflict of interest should arise, I would call the State Ethics office for a ruling, and abide by their decision.
