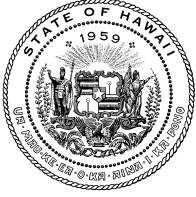

1 **Agency's Position:** The State Health Planning and Development Agency supports the
2 nomination and confirmation of Mr. Jay Alan Raymundo to the West Oahu Subarea Health
3 Planning Council (WOSAC).

5 **Purpose and Justification:** The purpose is for the consideration and confirmation of the
6 WOSAC Gubernatorial Nominee, Mr. Jay Alan Raymundo.

7 Mr. Raymundo is currently the CEO of Aloha Habilitation Services, a home healthcare
8 agency in Mililani, and Board Member of the Wahiawa Center for Community Health. He
9 previously worked as a Case Manager for The ARC of Greater Waltham, Massachusetts.
10 Active in the community, he was President of the Filipino Junior Chamber of Hawaii in 2011
11 and of the Hawaii Junior Chamber in 2013. He continues to serve as Board Member of the
12 Hawaii Junior Chamber, the Filipino Chamber of Commerce of Hawaii, and the Hawaii Waiver
13 Providers' Association. Mr. Raymundo obtained his Bachelor of Arts degree in Biology from
14 Boston University, and has been recognized by Pacific Business Magazine as one of Hawaii's
15 Fastest 50 in 2010, and by Pacific Edge Magazine as Young Professional of the Year (finalist)
16 in 2012.

- (1) Why do you want to be a member of the Board?

I would like to learn more about how healthcare is addressed in our State through this agency.

Aside from the purpose and functions of the State Health Planning and Development Agency, I perceive the main responsibility is to promote opportunities to develop healthcare access and efficiency in our subareas as well as to ensure compliance.
