LATE TESTIMONY

I strongly support HB 1726 (Joel's Law).

My name is Nadine Onodera, and I am the Founder of Parents of Murdered Children in Hawaii. Over 32 years ago my son Michael was assassinated in our home in Hawaii Kai. Mike was 24 years old with no enemies or behavioral problems. He was a full time computer specialist at First Hawaiian Bank and a UH student.

Our neighbor, Deputy Attorney General Jay W. Nelson, had a long history of drug and alcohol abuse. About two months before my son's death, Jay sexually assaulted me and threatened to kill my husband. He meant to kill my husband Carl but mistook my son for Carl. Jay placed a gun against Mike's forehead because there was a bruise around the bullet hole indicating he restrained him before pulling the trigger.

The case is still unsolved, and I have come to accept it will always be, but it would give me and my family great comfort to know that others who died as Mike did will have their murderers punished appropriately.
