S.B. 1213 – RELATING TO PUBLIC SAFETY

The Hawaii Government Employees Association, AFSCME Local 152, AFL-CIO supports the purpose and intent of S.B. 1213. This legislation will allow an employer to seek a temporary restraining order and injunction against further harassment of an employee who has or may be harassed at a worksite.
