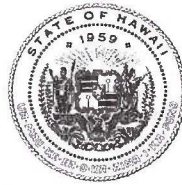

**S.B. 1334, S.D. 1
RELATING TO OPERATING A VEHICLE WHILE INTOXICATED**

Senate Committee on Judiciary and Labor

The Department of Transportation (DOT) **supports** S.B. 1334, S.D. 1 relating to operating a vehicle while intoxicated. This bill will allow law enforcement officers to tow a motor vehicle if the operator is arrested or cited for various alcohol-related traffic offenses.

By giving the authority to police to tow the vehicle upon arrest for driving intoxicated, it will be a strong deterrent for drivers to think about driving after drinking.

The DOT urges your support in passing S.B. 1134, S.D. 1 as it gives a strong message for those who continue to drink and drive.
