Dear Chair Shimabukuro, Chair Thielen, and Committee Members:

Thank you for this opportunity to submit testimony in opposition of SB 483, regarding forestry and Hawaiian homelands. My testimony is submitted in my capacity as the Economic Development & Intergovernmental Relations Committee Chair and as an individual Councilmember on the Kaua'i County Council.

SB 483 proposes to allow the Department of Hawaiian Home Lands (DHHL) to utilize Hawaiian home lands for forestry of koa or native trees and enter into a public-private partnership to implement a forestry plan. Although this Bill promotes forestry of koa or native trees, the proposed use of the lands is not in line with the purpose of the Hawaiian Homes Commission Act (HHCA). The HHCA was established to provide for the rehabilitation of native Hawaiians through the provision of land for residential, agricultural and pastoral homesteading. Furthermore, the Act allows native Hawaiians to access lands for mercantile licenses in support of native Hawaiian businesses. Conducting forestry to raise revenue on Hawaiian home lands does not serve homesteading purposes, thus I oppose this measure.

For the reasons stated above, I strongly encourage the Senate Joint Committee to defer this measure indefinitely. Should you have any questions, please feel free to contact me or Council Services Staff at (808) 241-4188.
