1) that, thru my late-father, my 'ohana are descendants of Kahakuloa, where I still own properties.... &, I am so pleased to inform you...

that, I receive KPOA Radio Broadcasts, here, in Waimanalo, where I, now, reside....

& I enjoy hearing the Hawaiian Music & Programming...

as well as, the "Maui Happenings".... that your Station shares...

2) that, I would like to request, that, your Station seriously consider sharing over the air-wayes....

the following important facts of Hawaiian & Maui Island history...

that, I have been sharing with the Hawai'i State Legislature....

through 4 "Initiatives"...

which request... that... LONG-OVERDUE Honor... (116 years)...

be PROPERLY AFFORDED.... a very famous Maui-Born Warrior Chief....

whose Birthday falls, next week, on, Monday, Feb. 15th....

but, whose importance to our Hawaiian People....

& whose significant life-time achievement... has been... forgotten... or, ocerlooked...

or, in my opinion.. purposely... IGNORED!

I composed & recorded.... a song for this Great Hawaiian... in 1976...

that.... I am sure.... with which, you are familiar, entitled...

"Ka Mamakakaua"...

which I felt it was important for me to compose....

after I had learned, through my hard-earned research...

that... in a loyal & courageous manner.... this courageous Mauian....

had defended the Honor of his King.... Kalakaua...

by leading.... on June 30th, 1889... an Armed Rebellion...

with less than, 100 Hawaiian Warriors... onto the Grounds of 'Iõlani Palace...

against the enemies of King Kalakaua...

who, were a 500-man mercenery-militia, called the "Honolulu Rifles"....

led by Missionary-Descendant, Lorrin Thurston....

who.... at the points of their bayoneted- Springfield Rifles...

had compelled King Kalakaua to sign...

what our Hawaiian Kupuna of that time.... called,

"The Bayonet Constitution Of 1887".

This same Maui Warrior-Chief... 6 years, later.... & 2 years after.... the January 17th, 1893, "Illegal Overthrow of Queen Lili'uokalani"....

would organize & lead... a brief...

but failed.... "Counter Revolution" of 1895.

Born on Feb. 15th, 1855, this popular Hawaiian hero...

was a descendant of ancient Maui Island Ruler... Kauluhea... on his mother's side...

Despite his failed armed loyalist rebellions...

this highly intelligent 1/2 blooded Hawaiian Chief...

was a two-time elected Representative.... to the Kingdom of Hawai'i's

Legislature.... as a Member of the "House Of Representatives"...

However, his greatest UNPRECEDENTED Political-Achievement...

actually, followed the "Illegal Annexation of Hawai'i"...

when, he was elected...

The "Territory Of Hawai'i's...

"1st Delegate-To- Congress"...

serving from 1900-1903.

His name was...

Robert William Kalanihiapo Wilcox ("Wilikoki" to his adoring Hawaiian People of that time)...

Unfortunately, his FINAL Life-Time Achievement....

has been OVER-SHADOWED.... by the Achievements of beloved.... Prince Jonah Kuhiõ Kalaniana'ole...

who was Hawai'i's 2nd "Delegate-To-Congress"...

but.... who had succeeded in having.... the "Hawaiian Homes Commission Act".... passed by Congress....

The "4 Honorific Initiatives"... that, I alluded to, above....

I have taken to the Legislature....

& am hopeful... will agree to adopt...

that, would be equivalant to the Honors, that were afforded Prince Jonah Kuhiõ Kalaniana'ole, many years, ago:

1) A Funded State Holiday on Kalanihiapo Wilikoki's Birthday....

Feb. 15th (next week Monday)...

perhaps, calling it.... "Kalanihiapo Wilikoki Day"

- 2) A Celebratory Holiday, organized, annually, by a Fully-Funded "Celebration Committee"....
- 3) A Major Highway or Freeway.... named in his honor.... in the same manner, that, "Kalaniana'ole Hwy" was named for our beloved Prince...
- 4) A Major Highway, and other important relevant land-marks....

on the Island Of Maui.... be named for this Native-Maui Chief....

just as, "Kuhiō Ave"... & "Kuhiō Beach & Mall".... in Waikiki.... are named for our beloved 2nd Delegate-To-Congress".... to honor his residence, that once stood, in the area...

I hope that you will agree with me....

that, the Fame & Achievements of this "Royal Son of Maui"....

ought to be brought to the attention of Maui's People...

& I ask.... that, KPOA, be...

the Broadcast Station that becomes "The Voice" to inform ALL OF MAUI...
