Application for Grant Fiscal Year 2018 Maui County Composite Squadron, Civil Air Patrol Aerospace Education STEM Outreach for Middle School Students on Maui

I. Background and Summary

- 1. Maui County Composite Squadron has been serving the Island of Maui since 1976 focused on 3 missions of Aerospace Education, Emergency Services, and Cadet Leadership Program. It was merged with another squadron to form a single Maui Squadron on 17 November 2016 to take advantage of economy of scale and maximize membership efforts. Last year the aerospace education outreach program was introduced to 3 schools on Maui through workshops. All outreach programs are accomplished through member's volunteer service.
- 2. We would like to expand the acquisition of supplies and expand our outreach program. Volunteers bring supplies to the classroom and provide hands on learning for students in the field of aerospace and engineering. Supplies for individual experiments typically cost about \$5 per student per experiment and we can accomplish up to 3 experiments per student per workshop to date, this has all been member self funded.
- 3. Exposing students to STEM related topics, careers, and opportunities remains a priority. Maui County Composite Squadron uses Civil Air Patrol curriculum, which complies with common core and incorporates all subjects of language, history, math, and science. Aerospace and Engineering experiments are an engaging way for middle school students can get hands on visual means of exploring STEM related topics.
- 4. We would like to focus our outreach program on 6-8 grades. It is known this is when females especially have a tendency to move away from science and engineering related electives and projects. By getting into the classrooms and conducting hands on learning workshops, we hope to excite the students to a wonderful world of STEM related careers and opportunities.
- 5. This outreach program intends to cover the island of Maui public middle schools, shopping mall exhibits, and 4th Friday table demonstrations.

- 1. Volunteers will make contact with local middle schools, secure required supplies for successful experiments, and deliver educational materials to groups of middle school students.
- 2. Following the DOE school year calendar, workshops will be offered throughout school times to the benefit of teacher and administration schedules for the individual districts.
