ACTION REQUESTED:	Annual report to the Legislature
DOE REPORT:	Relating to Administrative Hearing Procedures and Subpoena Power Relating to the Education of Children with a Disability
Introduction:	Section 302A-443(e), HRS requires the DOE to annually submit a report that provides the "total number of requests for a due process hearing relating to the reimbursement of costs for a child's placement filed by a parent or guardian of a child with a disability."
Findings:	During school year 2015-2016, there were 62 due process hearing requests filed requesting reimbursement of costs for a child's placement filed by a parent or guardian of a child with a disability.
