

STATUS OF THE GAME MANAGEMENT ADVISORY COMMISSION

PURPOSE

Act 210, Session Laws of Hawaii (SLH) 2016, amended Chapter 183D, Hawaii Revised Statutes, by adding a new section (Section 183D-4.5) to establish the Game Management Advisory Commission to serve in an advisory capacity to the Board of Land and Natural Resources. This section also requires an annual report to be submitted by the Game Management Advisory Commission of its efforts to comply with Act 210, SLH 2016, including a summary of its activities during the year preceding the regular legislative session for which the report was prepared.

SUMMARY OF ACTIVITIES

The Game Management Advisory Commission is made up of nine members:

- (1) One member from the County of Kauai;
- (2) Three members from the County of Maui, with one member from each of the Islands of Maui, Lanai, and Molokai;
- (3) Two members from the County of Hawaii, with one member from West Hawaii and one member from East Hawaii;
- (4) One member from the City and County of Honolulu;
- (5) One at-large member; and
- (6) The Chairperson of the Board of Land and Natural Resources or the Chairperson's designated representative, who shall serve as an ex officio voting member;

to be appointed by the Governor in the manner provided by Section 26-34, HRS.

The Office of the Governor is in the process of accepting membership applications from individuals interested in serving on the Game Management Advisory Commission.
