Section 302A-431, Hawai'i Revised Statutes

Section 302A-431, Hawai'i Revised Statutes, requires the University of Hawai'i – along with the Department of Education – to submit a biennial report to the governor and the legislature prior to the convening of each regular session in the first year of each biennium that identifies the cost impacts to the State of providing workers' compensation coverage for students under sections 302A-430 and 302A-440.

Below is a list of claims to the University of Hawai'i for workers' comp coverage and cost impacts to the state since implementation of this reporting requirement via Act 344, Session Laws of Hawai'i 1997.
