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**A BILL FOR AN ACT**

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

2 that are not expended or encumbered by June 30, 2018, and  
3 June 30, 2019, of the respective fiscal years, shall lapse as of  
4 those dates.

5 SECTION 19. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2017.
