A BILL FOR AN ACT

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

4 SECTION 10. Funds appropriated by this Act that are not
5 expended or encumbered by June 30, 2018, and June 30, 2019, of
6 the respective fiscal years, shall lapse as of those dates.

7 SECTION 11. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2017.




