# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC EMPLOYMENT COST ITEMS.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1 PART I

2 SECTION 1. There are appropriated or authorized from the  
3 sources of funding indicated below to collective bargaining  
4 statewide (BUF 102) the following sums or so much thereof as may  
5 be necessary to fund for fiscal biennium 2017-2019 all  
6 collective bargaining cost items in the agreement negotiated  
7 with the exclusive bargaining representative of collective  
8 bargaining unit (11):

9 General Funds	\$75,838	\$181,365
10 Special Funds	\$394,057	\$942,911

12 SECTION 2. Funds appropriated or authorized by this part  
13 shall be allotted by the director of finance to the appropriate  
14 state departments for expenditure in the respective fiscal year  
15 for the purposes of this part.

18 sources of funding indicated below to collective bargaining

8 SECTION 7. There are appropriated from the source of  
9 funding indicated below to health premium payments (BUF 761) the  
10 following sums or so much thereof as may be necessary to fund  
11 for fiscal biennium 2017-2019 the Hawaii employer-union health  
12 benefits trust fund costs authorized by chapter 89C, Hawaii  
13 Revised Statutes, for state officers and employees who are  
14 excluded from collective bargaining and belong to the same  
15 compensation plans as those officers and employees within  
16 collective bargaining unit (11):

19 SECTION 8. Funds appropriated by this part shall be  
20 allotted by the director of finance to the appropriate state

3 PART V

4 SECTION 9. Salary increases and cost adjustments provided  
5 in this Act for any officer or employee whose compensation is  
6 paid, in whole or in part, from federal, special, or other funds  
7 shall be paid wholly or proportionately, as the case may be,  
8 from the respective funds.

9 SECTION 10. Funds appropriated or authorized by this Act  
10 that are not expended or encumbered by June 30, 2018, and  
11 June 30, 2019, of the respective fiscal years, shall lapse as of  
12 those dates.

13 SECTION 11. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2017.


