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# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, AIRPORTS DIVISION,  
PROJECT ADJUSTMENT FUND.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the Supplemental  
2 Appropriations Act of 2016, Act 124, Session Laws of Hawaii  
3 2016, item C-38.02, project adjustment fund, statewide,  
4 establishes a contingency fund for the airports division's  
5 project adjustment purposes, subject to the provisions of Act  
6 124. However, Act 124, which amends Act 119, Session Laws of  
7 Hawaii 2015, does not contain a budget proviso that permits the  
8 utilization of the department of transportation, airports  
9 division, project adjustment fund. A budget proviso relating to  
10 the department of transportation, airports division, project  
11 adjustment fund is necessary to authorize the governor to make  
12 supplemental allotments from the project adjustment fund to  
13 supplement any currently authorized capital investment cost  
14 elements for airports division capital improvement projects.

15           SECTION 2. Act 119, Session Laws of Hawaii 2015, as  
16 amended by Act 124, Session Laws of Hawaii 2016, is amended by  
17 adding a new section to Part VII to read as follows:



1        "SECTION . If authorized appropriations specified for  
2 department of transportation, airports division, capital  
3 improvement projects listed in this Act or in any other act  
4 currently authorized by the legislature are insufficient, and  
5 where the source of funding for the project is designated as  
6 revenue bond funds, the governor may make supplemental  
7 allotments from the department of transportation, airports  
8 division, project adjustment fund appropriated in part II and  
9 described in part IV of this Act to supplement any currently  
10 authorized capital investment cost elements; provided that the  
11 supplemental allotments from the project adjustment fund shall  
12 not be used to increase the scope of the project; and provided  
13 further that the governor shall submit a report to the  
14 legislature of all uses of this authority for the previous  
15 twelve month period from December 1 to November 30 no later than  
16 thirty days prior to the convening of the regular session of  
17 2018."

18        SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.

19        SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.




