# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. In 1992, Hurricane Iniki struck Kauai, damaging 2 seven thousand homes and causing \$2,000,000,000 in property
- 3 damage. A 2011 Federal Emergency Management Agency Risk
- 4 Assessment indicates a similar strike on Oahu could cause eight
- 5 times that amount of damage.
- 6 The legislature finds that Hawaii residents require
- 7 education on emergency and disaster preparedness, as indicated
- 8 by residents:
- 9 (1) Rushing to the stores for food and water whenever10 there is a threatening event;
- 11 (2) Returning these supplies after the event;
- 12 (3) Complaining about short-term power outages; and
- (4) Failing to understand the difference between hurricaneversus tsunami evacuation planning.
- 15 The legislature further finds that in light of the record
- 16 number of hurricane warnings and misses in 2014, 2015, and 2016,
- 17 the State has been very fortunate, but must take stronger action
