# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE REPEAL OF SECTION 325-15, HAWAII REVISED STATUTES.


#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The legislature finds that mandatory testing
for tuberculosis of United States citizens returning from
certain areas after absences of five or more years provides
marginal benefits to tuberculosis control in Hawaii and is
costly to maintain and impractical to enforce. Repealing this
requirement will diminish burdens for travelers without
significant risk to public health.

8 The purpose of this Act is to repeal section 325-15, Hawaii Revised Statutes, which requires United States citizens or 9 10 nationals upon returning to the State after five or more years' 11 residence in any United States territory or possession, or any 12 foreign country, with a high occurrence of infectious and 13 communicable diseases, to submit a medical examination report 14 that shall include a tuberculin skin test or a chest x-ray 15 examination, and in the case of a positive skin test, a chest 16 x-ray report, to the department of health within sixty days of 17 returning to the State.

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SECTION 2. Section 325-15, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 2 repealed.

3	[" <del>[§325-15] Infectious and communicable diseases,</del>
4	examination and treatment. United States citizens or nationals,
5	upon-returning-to-this State after five or more years residence
6	in any territory or possession of the United States, or any
7	foreign country, with a high occurrence of infectious and
8	communicable-diseases, shall submit a medical examination report
9	that shall-include a tuberculin skin-test or a chest x-ray
10	examination, and in the case of a positive skin test a chest x-
11	ray report shall be submitted, to the department of health
12	within-sixty days of return to this State. The department of
13	health shall cooperate with public and private authorities,
14	where-feasible, in implementing this section."]
15	SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
16	and stricken.
17	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2017.
