## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TUBERCULOSIS TESTING.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to require the
2	department of health to accept Food and Drug Administration-
3	approved, Centers for Disease Control and Prevention-recommended
4	tests for tuberculosis infection in addition to the Mantoux
5	tuberculin skin test for the purpose of obtaining a certificate
6	of tuberculosis examination. Many individuals are required to
7	be tested for tuberculosis: children entering school, school
8	personnel, personnel working with higher-risk populations,
9	students enrolling in higher education programs, and others.
10	The addition of the Food and Drug Administration-approved,
11	Centers for Disease Control and Prevention-recommended tests for
12	tuberculosis infection as an approved tuberculosis diagnostic is
13	necessary because these tests are appropriate for those who have
14	received the bacille Calmette-Guerin tuberculosis vaccine,
15	individuals opposed to the tuberculin injection, and individuals
16	for whom returning for a second appointment to check for a skin
17	reaction is a hardship. There is no intent to change current
18	requirements or procedures regarding the use of the Mantoux 2017-2534 SB194 CD1 SMA.doc

- 1 tuberculin skin test or chest x-rays in obtaining a certificate
- 2 of tuberculosis examination. Rather, the only intent of this
- 3 Act is to provide for an additional accepted diagnostic.
- 4 SECTION 2. The department of health shall accept the
- 5 results of any tuberculosis blood test that is a Food and Drug
- 6 Administration-approved, Centers for Disease Control and
- 7 Prevention-recommended test for tuberculosis infection for the
- 8 purpose of obtaining a certificate of tuberculosis examination.
- 9 SECTION 3. Section 302A-1154, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 10 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:
- "(b) No child shall attend any school for the first time
- 12 in the State unless the child presents to the appropriate school
- 13 official documentation satisfactory to the department of health
- 14 that the child has been examined and tested according to the
- 15 rules of the department [7] and law and is free from tuberculosis
- in a communicable form."
- 17 SECTION 4. The department of health shall amend its
- 18 administrative rules to reflect the addition of a Food and Drug
- 19 Administration-approved, Centers for Disease Control and
- 20 Prevention-recommended test for tuberculosis infection as an
- 21 alternative to the Mantoux tuberculin skin test as an acceptable

- 1 diagnostic for the purpose of obtaining a tuberculosis
- 2 examination certificate.
- 3 SECTION 5. Any existing administrative rules and
- 4 procedures regarding the use of the Mantoux tuberculin skin test
- 5 or chest x-rays in obtaining a certificate of tuberculosis
- 6 examination shall remain in effect until amended to include the
- 7 addition of Food and Drug Administration-approved, Centers for
- 8 Disease Control and Prevention-recommended tests for
- 9 tuberculosis infection as an acceptable tuberculosis diagnostic
- 10 pursuant to section 4.
- 11 SECTION 6. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 12 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 13 SECTION 7. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
