
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE AEROSPACE ADVISORY COMMITTEE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 201-72.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

3 "(a) There is established an aerospace advisory committee
4 within the office of aerospace development of the department of
5 business, economic development, and tourism for administrative
6 purposes. The committee shall be composed of thirteen members
7 [~~appointed by the governor, as provided in section 26-34, except~~
8 ~~as otherwise]~~ as provided in this section. Of the thirteen
9 members:

10 (1) Three members shall be representatives of the
11 aerospace industry[~~-~~] and appointed by the governor,
12 as provided in section 26-34. One member shall be
13 appointed from a list of nominees submitted by the
14 president of the senate, and one member shall be
15 appointed from a list of nominees submitted by the
16 speaker of the house of representatives;

- 1 (2) Three members shall be representatives of the
2 aerospace industry in this State~~[-]~~ and appointed by
3 the governor, as provided in section 26-34. One
4 member shall be appointed from a list of nominees
5 submitted by the president of the senate, and one
6 member shall be appointed from a list of nominees
7 submitted by the speaker of the house of
8 representatives;
- 9 (3) Four members shall represent the economic development
10 boards of Kauai, Oahu, Maui, and Hawaii, respectively,
11 to be ~~[appointed, respectively, from a list of~~
12 ~~nominees submitted]~~ selected by each of these economic
13 development boards; and
- 14 (4) Three members shall represent the University of Hawaii
15 at Manoa, University of Hawaii at Hilo, and University
16 of Hawaii community college system, respectively, to
17 be ~~[appointed, one each, from a list of nominees~~
18 ~~submitted]~~ selected by the University of Hawaii at
19 Manoa, University of Hawaii at Hilo, and University of
20 Hawaii community college system, respectively.
- 21 The committee shall elect one of its members to serve as
22 chairperson."
