
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO BOILER AND ELEVATOR SAFETY LAW.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 397-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending the definition of "elevators and kindred
3 equipment" to read as follows:

4 "Elevators and kindred equipment" as used in this chapter
5 means elevators, escalators, dumbwaiters, moving walks, stage
6 lifts, [~~mechanized parking elevators, manlifts,~~] inclined lifts,
7 personnel hoists, [~~aerial tramways,~~] permanently installed
8 material lifts, [~~personal automatic trains~~] and any other
9 similar mechanized equipment used to convey people in places
10 other than a public right-of-way."

11 SECTION 2. Section 397-5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
12 amended by amending subsection (c) to read as follows:

13 "(c) Effective July 1, 2012, the fees for inspections,
14 permits, and examinations of boilers, pressure systems,
15 elevators, kindred equipment, and amusement rides shall be as
16 prescribed by the schedules in this section; provided that the



1 director may adopt rules pursuant to chapter 91 to amend the
2 fees specified in this section.

1	Inclined tunnel lifts	\$500
2	(For elevators, such as observation or deep well	
3	elevators, which have considerable rise but few	
4	openings, each ten feet of vertical rise shall be	
5	considered one floor for the purpose of determining	
6	installation or alteration permit fees.)	
7	(6) Temporary use permits (construction car)	\$450
8	(7) For each valid alteration or installation permit, the	
9	department shall provide one inspection per unit.	
10	(8) The fee for each additional inspection or witnessing	
11	of tests, or both, shall be \$300 per day for up to two	
12	hours and \$600 per day for more than two hours if	
13	during the normal workday. Fees for overtime hours	
14	shall be \$600 per day for up to two hours and \$1,200	
15	per day for more than two hours.	
16	(9) Each installation or alteration permit shall be valid	
17	for up to one year from the date of issuance.

 3 hours and \$600 per day for more than two hours. Fees
 4 for overtime hours shall be \$600 per day for up to two
 5 hours and \$1,200 per day for more than two hours.

6 SCHEDULE C: Amusement Ride Fees

7 Inspection Fees:

8 (1) Permit renewal inspection fees:

9 Amusement ride	\$100

10 (2) Permit renewal fees are per inspection, which may
 11 constitute one day or part of the day. If the
 12 inspector has to return on another day or at another
 13 time within the same day, additional fees shall be
 14 assessed at the rate of \$300 per day for up to two
 15 hours and \$600 per day for more than two hours. Fees
 16 for overtime hours shall be \$600 per day for up to two
 17 hours and \$1,200 per day for more than two hours."

18 SECTION 3. Section 397-13, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
 19 amended as follows:

20 1. By amending its title to read:



1 "~~[+]~~ §397-13 ~~[+]~~ Boiler and elevator special fund;
2 establishment; purposes."

3 2. By amending subsection (d) to read:

4 "(d) No later than ~~[five]~~ ten years from the date of the
5 establishment of the special fund, the director shall reimburse
6 the general fund for the amount of any initial appropriation
7 that was made by the general revenues of the State to the
8 special fund."

9 SECTION 4. This Act does not affect the rights and duties
10 that matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that
11 were begun before its effective date.

12 SECTION 5. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
13 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

14 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
