## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ELECTIONS.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. Section 11-411, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended to read as follows:

3           "[-]§11-411[+] **Criminal referral.** In lieu of an  
4 administrative determination that a violation of this part has  
5 been committed, the commission may refer the complaint to the  
6 attorney general or county prosecutor at any time it believes  
7 the respondent may have [~~recklessly~~] knowingly[~~7~~] or  
8 intentionally committed a violation."

9           SECTION 2. Section 11-412, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
10 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

11           "(a) Any person who [~~recklessly~~] knowingly[~~7~~] or  
12 intentionally violates any provision of this part shall be  
13 guilty of a misdemeanor."

14           SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed  
15 and stricken.
