

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE CONVEYANCE TAX.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Section 247-7, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is	
2	amended to read as follows:		
3	"§24'	7-7 Disposition of taxes. All taxes collected under	
4	this chap	ter shall be paid into the state treasury to the credit	
5	of the gen	neral fund of the State, to be used and expended for	
6	the purpos	ses for which the general fund was created and exists	
7	by law; p	rovided that of the taxes collected each fiscal year:	
8	(1)	Ten per cent or \$6,800,000, whichever is less, shall	
9		be paid into the land conservation fund established	
10		pursuant to section 173A-5; [and]	
11	(2)	Fifty per cent or \$38,000,000, whichever is less,	
12		shall be paid into the rental housing revolving fund	
13		established by section 201H-202[+]; and	
14	(3)	One per cent or , whichever is less, shall be	
15		paid into the education design and construction	
16		project assessment fund established by section 302A-	
17		1508."

1	SECTI	ION 2. Section 302A-1508, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by	amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
3	"(a)	There shall be established in the department a
4	revolving	fund to be known as the education design and
5	constructi	on project assessment fund for the purpose of
6	defraying	the costs of:
7	(1)	Carrying out construction projects managed by the
8		department;
9	(2)	Managing funds representing accumulated vacation and
10		sick leave credits and retirement benefits for non-
11		general fund employees in the construction program in
12		accordance with section 78-23;
13	(3)	Equitably collecting and distributing moneys for other
14		current expenses associated with capital improvement,
15		repairs and maintenance, and repairs and alterations
16		projects; and
17	(4)	Managing payments for employee transportation
18		requirements such as car mileage reimbursements in
19		accordance with applicable law and collective
20		hargaining agrooments

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- 1 The fund shall consist of moneys appropriated to the fund by the
- 2 legislature, assessments collected pursuant to subsection (b),
- 3 conveyance tax revenues pursuant to section 247-7, all interest
- 4 attributable to investment of money deposited in the fund, and
- 5 moneys allotted to the fund from other sources."
- 6 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 7 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

8 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2017.
