

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE SIXTH REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2	general obligation bonds in the sum of \$139,265,250 or so much
3	thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof
4	as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2017-2018
5	for the purpose of financing capital improvement projects for
6	the sixth representative district, as follows:

4	the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriation is made;
5	provided that all moneys from the appropriation that are
6	unencumbered as of June 30, 2020, shall lapse as of that date.
7	SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective
8	capital improvement projects set forth in section 1 shall be
9	expended by the designated expending agency for the purposes of
10	this Act.
11	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2017.
