
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TRANSPORTATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 286, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3 and to read as follows:

4 "§286- Autocycles. (a) Every autocycle operated in
5 this State shall first be registered as a motor vehicle as
6 provided in section 286-41.

7 (b) No person shall operate an autocycle on a public
8 street, road, or highway in this State unless the person
9 possesses a valid driver's license pursuant to section 286-102
10 and the autocycle has been duly registered pursuant to
11 subsection (a)."

12 SECTION 2. Section 286-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
13 amended by adding a new definition to be appropriately inserted
14 and to read as follows:

15 "Autocycle" means a three-wheeled motor vehicle with a
16 steering wheel and non-straddle seating that is manufactured to
17 federal motorcycle safety standards."

1 SECTION 3. Section 286-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending the definition of "motorcycle" to read as
3 follows:

4 "Motorcycle" means every motor vehicle having a seat or
5 saddle for use of the rider and designed to travel on not more
6 than three wheels in contact with the ground, including an
7 autocycle, but [~~excludes~~] excluding a farm tractor and a moped."

8 SECTION 4. Section 291C-152, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
9 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:

10 "(b) [A] For motorcycles equipped with straddle seating, a
11 person shall ride upon [a] the motorcycle only while sitting
12 astride the seat, facing forward, with one leg on each side of
13 the motorcycle."

14 SECTION 5. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
15 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

16 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
