A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ENERGY EFFICIENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that energy efficiency is
- 2 a cornerstone of the State's transition to clean energy. It is
- 3 also a strong mechanism for protecting consumers from high
- 4 energy costs. The legislature has repeatedly found that
- 5 promoting greater energy efficiency is in the public's interest.
- 6 The purpose of this Act is to establish an energy
- 7 efficiency task force to make recommendations on energy
- 8 proposals to ensure cost savings to all rate payers.
- 9 SECTION 2. (a) The director of business, economic
- 10 development, and tourism shall establish the energy efficiency
- 11 task force to make recommendations on energy proposals and
- 12 standards. The director shall initiate the organization of and
- 13 provide staff support for the task force.
- (b) The director shall invite representatives of the
- 15 following agencies to participate in the task force:
- 16 (1) State energy office;
- 17 (2) State building code council;

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1	(3)	A county building official from each of the four
2		counties appointed by the mayor;
3	(4)	Structural Engineers Association of Hawaii;
4	(5)	American Institute of Architects, Hawaii State
5		Council; and
6	(6)	Any additional members from various sectors, to be
7		selected at the discretion of the director.
8	The members of the task force shall serve without	
9	compensation.	
10	(c)	The task force shall submit an interim report of its
11	findings	and recommendations, including any proposed
12	legislati	on, to the legislature no later than twenty days prior
13	to the convening of the regular session of 2018. The interim	
14	report sh	all include, but shall not be limited to:
15	(1)	New energy efficiency proposals and standards that
16		existing and new commercial buildings or structures
17		can follow to become more energy efficient.
18	(2)	Proposals to define allowable air curtain or other
19		retrofit technologies sufficient to protect against
20		the co-mingling of indoor and outdoor air in

commercial buildings and structures;

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1	(3)	Proposals to implement design and construction
2		parameters for new commercial construction to avoid
3		open-door air conditioning in the future;
4	(4)	Proposals for emergency efficiency standards to be
5		include in the state building code with respect to
6		commercial construction; and
7	(5)	Proposals to ensure energy cost savings to all rate
8		payers.
9	(d)	The task force shall submit a final report of its
10	finding and recommendations, including any proposed legislation	
11	to the legislature no later than twenty days prior to the	
12	convening	of the regular session of 2019.
13	(e)	The task force shall terminate on July 1, 2019.
14	SECT	ION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
