A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO AGRICULTURE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that Act 99, Session Laws 2 of 2013, established the Hawaii agriculture workforce advisory 3 board to advise the department of labor and industrial relations 4 on, among other things, projects and programs recommended to 5 promote the expansion and development of the State's 6 agricultural industry. 7 The purpose of this Act is to implement the recommendation 8 of the Hawaii agriculture workforce advisory board that the 9 State create an agriculture workforce development pipeline 10 initiative to conduct training on all islands for teachers and 11 school administrators in agricultural self-sufficiency. SECTION 2. Chapter 371, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 12 13 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated 14 and to read as follows: 15 "§371- K-12 agriculture workforce development pipeline 16 initiative. (a) There is established in the department a K-12

1 training sessions on all islands for teachers and school 2 administrators regarding agricultural self-sufficiency. 3 (b) The K-12 agriculture workforce development pipeline 4 initiative shall be headed by a resource teacher who shall be a 5 member of bargaining unit (5) and who shall be appointed by the 6 director, subject to chapter 76. The resource teacher shall 7 develop and propose incentives, including scholarships, travel 8 offsets, course credits, and stipends. The resource teacher may 9 hire, subject to chapter 76, necessary staff to carry out the **10** purposes of this section. 11 (c) Course material for the training sessions under subsection (a) shall be approved by the Hawaii agriculture 12 13 workforce advisory board established pursuant to section 371-19. 14 The department shall submit annual reports to the 15 legislature on the activities of the K-12 agriculture workforce 16 development pipeline initiative not later than twenty days prior 17 to the convening of each regular session." 18 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general 19 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$75,000 or so much 20 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2017-2018 and the 21 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year

- 2 resource teacher.
- 3 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
- 4 of labor and industrial relations for the purposes of this Act.

- 6 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2017.
