
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HIGH TECHNOLOGY DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the high technology
2 development corporation is a key state agency in developing and
3 supporting the manufacturing industry in the State. The
4 legislature believes that the continuation of the manufacturing
5 development program administered by the high technology
6 development corporation is of great importance in supporting the
7 manufacturing industry.

8 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
9 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$1,500,000 or so much
10 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2017-2018 and the
11 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
12 2018-2019 for the purpose of continuing the operations and
13 administration of the manufacturing development program.

14 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the high
15 technology development corporation for the purposes of this Act.
