### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TAXATION.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 245-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows: 2 Every wholesaler or dealer, in addition to any other 3 "(a) taxes provided by law, shall pay for the privilege of conducting 4 5 business and other activities in the State: An excise tax equal to 5.00 cents for each cigarette 6 (1)sold, used, or possessed by a wholesaler or dealer 7 after June 30, 1998, whether or not sold at wholesale, 8 9 or if not sold then at the same rate upon the use by the wholesaler or dealer; 10 An excise tax equal to 6.00 cents for each cigarette 11 (2) sold, used, or possessed by a wholesaler or dealer 12 after September 30, 2002, whether or not sold at 13 wholesale, or if not sold then at the same rate upon 14 the use by the wholesaler or dealer; 15 An excise tax equal to 6.50 cents for each cigarette 16 (3)

sold, used, or possessed by a wholesaler or dealer

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1 after June 30, 2003, whether or not sold at wholesale, 2 or if not sold then at the same rate upon the use by 3 the wholesaler or dealer; 4 (4) An excise tax equal to 7.00 cents for each cigarette 5 sold, used, or possessed by a wholesaler or dealer 6 after June 30, 2004, whether or not sold at wholesale, 7 or if not sold then at the same rate upon the use by the wholesaler or dealer; 8 9 An excise tax equal to 8.00 cents for each cigarette (5) sold, used, or possessed by a wholesaler or dealer on 10 and after September 30, 2006, whether or not sold at 11 12 wholesale, or if not sold then at the same rate upon the use by the wholesaler or dealer; 13 An excise tax equal to 9.00 cents for each cigarette 14 (6) sold, used, or possessed by a wholesaler or dealer on 15 and after September 30, 2007, whether or not sold at 16 17 wholesale, or if not sold then at the same rate upon the use by the wholesaler or dealer; 18 19 An excise tax equal to 10.00 cents for each cigarette (7) sold, used, or possessed by a wholesaler or dealer on 20 21 and after September 30, 2008, whether or not sold at



wholesale, or if not sold then at the same rate upon 1 2 the use by the wholesaler or dealer; An excise tax equal to 13.00 cents for each cigarette 3 (8) sold, used, or possessed by a wholesaler or dealer on 4 5 and after July 1, 2009, whether or not sold at wholesale, or if not sold then at the same rate upon 6 7 the use by the wholesaler or dealer; An excise tax equal to 11.00 cents for each little 8 (9) cigar sold, used, or possessed by a wholesaler or 9 dealer on and after October 1, 2009, whether or not 10 sold at wholesale, or if not sold then at the same 11 12 rate upon the use by the wholesaler or dealer; An excise tax equal to 15.00 cents for each cigarette 13 (10)or little cigar sold, used, or possessed by a 14 wholesaler or dealer on and after July 1, 2010, 15 whether or not sold at wholesale, or if not sold then 16 at the same rate upon the use by the wholesaler or 17 18 dealer; An excise tax equal to 16.00 cents for each cigarette 19 (11)or little cigar sold, used, or possessed by a 20 21 wholesaler or dealer on and after July 1, 2011,

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1		whether or not sold at wholesale, or if not sold then
2		at the same rate upon the use by the wholesaler or
3		dealer;
4	(12)	An excise tax equal to seventy per cent of the
5		wholesale price of each article or item of tobacco
6		products, other than large cigars, sold by the
7		wholesaler or dealer on and after September 30, 2009,
8		whether or not sold at wholesale, or if not sold then
9		at the same rate upon the use by the wholesaler or
10		dealer; [ <del>and</del> ]
11	(13)	An excise tax equal to fifty per cent of the wholesale
12		price of each large cigar of any length, sold, used,
13		or possessed by a wholesaler or dealer on and after
14		September 30, 2009, whether or not sold at wholesale,
15		or if not sold then at the same rate upon the use by
16		the wholesaler or dealer [-]; and
17	(14)	An excise tax equal to the lesser of:
18		(A) Fifty cents for each large cigar of any length;
19		or
20		(B) Fifty per cent of the wholesale price of each
21		large cigar of any length,



1	sold, used, or possessed by a wholesaler or dealer on
2	and after July 1, 2017, whether or not sold at
3	wholesale, or if not sold then at the same rate upon
4	the use by the wholesaler or dealer.
5	Where the tax imposed has been paid on cigarettes, little
6	cigars, or tobacco products that thereafter become the subject
7	of a casualty loss deduction allowable under chapter 235, the
8	tax paid shall be refunded or credited to the account of the
9	wholesaler or dealer. The tax shall be applied to cigarettes
10	through the use of stamps."
11	SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
12	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
13	SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2017.
