SECTION 1. Section 24-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
amended to read as follows:

6	cover all personal expenses such as board, lodging, and

9	(1)	Not exceed the greater of the maximum allowance for
10		such expenses payable to any public officer or
11		employee of the federal government or the State;

4 The allowance shall be paid to each member at the rate 5 prescribed for each day, from the first to the last day of each 6 session, including Saturdays, Sundays, holidays, and days of recess pursuant to the mandatory recess required by article III, 7 8 section 10, of the Constitution or a concurrent resolution, 9 except for days of recess when a session of the legislature is 10 recessed for more than three days pursuant to a concurrent 11 resolution and for days of unexcused absence of the member from 12 a meeting of the respective house."
