
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
THIRTY-SIXTH REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of _____ or so much thereof
3 as may be necessary, and the same sum or so much thereof as may
4 be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2017-2018 for the
5 purpose of capital improvement projects for the thirty-sixth
6 representative district, as follows:


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1 SECTION 2. The sums appropriated for the respective
