
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO KALAELOA AIRPORT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 261, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3 and to read as follows:

4 "§261- Kalaeloa airport tenant advisory board. (a)

5 There is established within the department of transportation for
6 administrative purposes a Kalaeloa airport tenant advisory
7 board. The advisory board shall consist of:

8 (1) One member of the senate who represents the Kalaeloa
9 airport area, to be selected by the senate president,
10 and who shall serve as an ex officio member;

11 (2) One member of the house of representatives who
12 represents the Kalaeloa airport area, to be selected
13 by the speaker of the house of representatives, and
14 who shall serve as an ex officio member;

15 (3) Two general aviation tenants of Kalaeloa airport who
16 shall be appointed by the governor as provided in
17 section 26-34; and

1 (4) Two airport operators at Kalaeloa airport who shall be
2 appointed by the governor as provided in section
3 26-34.

4 (b) The Kalaeloa airport tenant advisory board shall:

5 (1) Seek input from individuals and businesses interested
6 in issues relating to tenancy at Kalaeloa airport;

7 (2) Communicate regularly with the department about issues
8 that directly impact general aviation tenants; and

9 (3) Recommend policies to the department relating to
10 general aviation tenants at Kalaeloa airport.

11 (c) Members of the board shall serve without compensation
12 but shall be reimbursed for expenses, including travel expenses,
13 actually incurred in the performance of their duties."

14 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.

15 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
