RELATING TO GOVERNMENT SERVICES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 21F-6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended to read as follows:
3 "~~[+]§21F-6[+]~~ Office of the legislative analyst
4 established. (a) There is established the office of the
5 legislative analyst to be administered by the committee. The
6 committee shall appoint a legislative analyst who shall serve
7 for a ~~[period]~~ term of four years. The committee~~[, by a three-~~
8 ~~fourths vote of its members,]~~ may remove the legislative analyst
9 from ~~[office,]~~ office by a three-fourths vote of its members,
10 but only for cause. The committee shall fix the salary of the
11 legislative analyst.
12 (b) The legislative analyst may employ other clerical and
13 technical employees as may be necessary to carry out the
14 functions of the office. The legislative analyst and other
15 clerical and technical employees ~~[shall be entitled to]~~ may
16 participate in any employee benefit program plan or privilege
17 generally available to state employees."




